Find a Facility in Your State

To locate the drug and alcohol abuse treatment programs nearest you, find your **State** on the map below and click on it.

If someone you know needs help for alcohol or drug abuse problems or addiction where do you turn to find treatment? The Substance Abuse Treatment Facility Locator was created for just this purpose.

The Substance Abuse Treatment Facility Locator is an online searchable directory providing the location and services of more than 11,000 alcohol and drug abuse treatment facilities and programs in the United States. It also includes facilities in Puerto Rico, Guam, the Federated States of Micronesia, Palau, and the Virgin Islands.

The Locator lists outpatient, residential, hospital inpatient, and partial hospitalization/day treatment facilities and programs, as well as halfway houses. It includes facilities that provide detoxification, treatment, and treatment with methadone or buprenorphine.

The Substance Abuse Treatment Facility Locator is maintained by the Center for Behavioral Health Statistics and Quality, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). All information in the Locator is updated annually based on facility responses to SAMHSA's National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services. New facilities are added monthly. Updates to facility information are made within a week of notification.

Getting Started

Select a Search Type

The Locator has three ways to find facilities. Choose one by clicking a button on the left of the screen.

Find Facilities Near You—Find substance abuse treatment facilities nearest the street address, city, or zip code you enter. This search crosses state, city, and zip code boundaries.

Find Facilities by State, City, County, or Zip—Find substance abuse treatment facilities in the state, city, county, or zip code you enter. This search does **not** cross state, city, or zip code boundaries.

Find Facilities by Name—Find substance abuse treatment facilities by part or all of a facility name

Select Services (optional)

Use SELECT SERVICES to limit your search to facilities meeting your specific needs (Table 1).

Services may be checked as *Required* or *Optional*. Facilities listed will have *all* of the *Required* characteristics you checked. If you check any *Optional* services, the Locator listing will add the number of *Optional* services offered by each of the facilities listed.

Results

All search types produce a listing of 10 facilities at a time. Click *Next 10* to view the listing of the next 10 facilities or use the drop-down menu to select a group of facilities to view.

Toggle *Show All Details/Hide All Details* to show or hide detailed services information for all facilities, or toggle *Show/Hide* for individual facilities.

Click *Download* to download a comma-delimited file including facility name, location and mailing addresses, telephone numbers, website, and services.

Click *Map* to produce a street map and facility information for individual facilities.

Find Facilities Near You

Click the button *Near You* or click a state on the map. On the next screen, enter either a complete street address or a state, city or zip code. The Locator will use the street address or the center of the state, city or zip code as its starting point. Select a search distance in miles or kilometers.


Click SEARCH to complete the search, or click SELECT SERVICES to display a page that allows you to choose the services or other characteristics that a facility must have to be included in the search results.

The Locator displays a map and listing of the 10 facilities closest to the starting point.

Find Facilities Near You crosses state, city, county, and zip code boundaries. If your search crosses a State boundary, your results will include facilities in both States.

As an example, Figure 1 shows the result of a test search for treatment facilities within 20 miles of central Kansas City, Kansas. A total of 65 facilities were found. Note that some of these are in Kansas City, Missouri.

Find Facilities by State, City, County, or Zip Code

This search restricts results to the State(s), city, county, or zip code(s) you specify. Use this search type if you will be using Medicaid or other State-financed insurance to pay for your treatment and need to locate facilities only in your home State.

Click the button *By State, City, County or Zip*, then click one of the options on the next screen and use the drop-down menus for the option you selected.

Click SEARCH to complete the search, or click SELECT SERVICES to display a page that allows you to choose the services or other characteristics that a facility must have to be included in the search results.

The Locator displays a map and listing of 10 facilities at a time. The display is the same as in Figure 1 except that there is no *Distance* column.

Find Facilities By State, City, County or Zip does not cross state, city, county, or zip code boundaries. As an example, a test search for treatment facilities in Kansas City, Kansas, yielded 11 facilities, all within the city/state boundaries. Compare this to Figure 1, where 65 facilities were found within 20 miles of central Kansas City, Kansas, in both Kansas and Missouri.

Table 1. Search Categories Available in the Locator

<i>Category</i>	<i>Services Listed in Locator</i>
Primary Focus of Provider	Substance abuse treatment services, Mental health services, Mix of mental health and substance abuse services, General health services
Services Provided	Substance abuse treatment, Detoxification, Methadone maintenance, Methadone detoxification, Buprenorphine used in treatment, Halfway house
Type of Care	Hospital inpatient, Outpatient, Partial hospitalization/day treatment, Residential short-term treatment (30 days or less), Residential long-term treatment (more than 30 days),
Special Programs/ Groups Offered	Adolescents, Persons with co-occurring mental and substance abuse disorders, Persons with HIV/AIDS, Gays and lesbians, Senior/older adults, Pregnant/postpartum women, Women, Men, Residential beds for clients' children, DUI/DWI offenders, Criminal justice clients
Forms of Payment Accepted	Self payment, Medicaid, Medicare, State-financed insurance other than Medicaid, Private health insurance, Military insurance (e.g., VA, TRICARE), Access to Recovery voucher
Payment Assistance	Sliding fee scale (fee is based on income and other factors), Payment assistance (check with facility for details)
Special Language Services	ASL or other assistance for hearing impaired, Spanish, Native American or Alaska Native languages, Other languages

Find Facilities by Name

Click the button *By Name* to identify facilities based on all or part of a facility name. You can use this feature to find information quickly for a specific facility. You can also use this feature to locate facilities with characteristics not included in the SELECT SERVICES options. For example, treatment facilities associated with outdoor activities might be identified by a name search for “wilderness” or “ranch.”

Click SEARCH to complete the search. The Locator displays a listing of 10 facilities at a time.

Select Services

Use SELECT SERVICES to retrieve only those facilities meeting your needs (Table 1).

Check the services you require in the *Required* column. Check the services you would like but are not essential to you in the *Optional* column. Facilities listed will have *all* of the *Required* characteristics. The list will include the number of *Optional* services offered by each of the facilities listed. Facilities with *Optional* services will appear at the top of the list.

Example 1: You want to find an outpatient treatment facility within 20 miles of central Philadelphia. In the *Required* column, check *Outpatient* under *Type of Service*. Your search will retrieve all outpatient programs in the area you specified. (Our test retrieved 115 outpatient treatment facilities within 20 miles of central Philadelphia, crossing the border to include facilities in New Jersey as well as in Pennsylvania.)

Example 2: As in Example 1, you want to find an outpatient treatment facility within 20 miles of central Philadelphia. However, the facility must have a special program or group for adolescents. In the *Required* column, check *Outpatient* under *Type of Service* and check *Adolescents* under *Special Programs/Groups Offered*. Your search will retrieve all outpatient programs with programs for adolescents in the area you specified. (Our test retrieved 36 such facilities.)

Example 3: As in Example 2, you want to find an outpatient treatment facility within 20 miles of central Philadelphia, and it must have a special program or group for adolescents. It would be an advantage if the facility also had a program for pregnant women, but this is not necessary. In the *Required* column, check *Outpatient* under *Type of Service* and check *Adolescents* under *Special Programs/Groups Offered*. In the *Optional* column, check *Pregnant/postpartum women* under *Special Programs/Groups Offered*.

Your search will retrieve the same outpatient facilities with programs for adolescents as in Example 2, but those that also have programs for pregnant women will be listed first, and will have a "1" in the column showing the number of optional services. (Our test flagged 6 of the 36 facilities retrieved as also having a program for pregnant women.)

Example 4: As in Example 1, you want to find an outpatient treatment facility within 20 miles of central Philadelphia. It would be an advantage if the facility had special programs or groups for adolescents or for pregnant women, but this is not necessary. In the *Required* column, check *Outpatient* under *Type of Service*. In the *Optional* column, check *Adolescents* and *Pregnant/postpartum women* under *Special Programs/Groups Offered*.

Your search will retrieve the same outpatient programs as in Example 1, but those that have programs for both adolescents and pregnant women will be listed first, and will have a "2" in the column for number of optional services. Next the list shows facilities that have one of the optional characteristics, indicated by "1" in the column for the number of optional services. Finally, the list will show outpatient programs in the area specified that have neither of the optional characteristics. Click *Show Details* to see the facilities' services. (Our test flagged 6 of the 115 facilities retrieved as having programs for both adolescents and pregnant women, and another 33 as having a special program for one or the other.)

Other Links

Other features of the Locator include contact information for individual *State substance abuse agencies* and links to State websites.

Frequently Asked Questions responds to frequently-asked questions about using the Locator and getting listed in the Locator.

Links to Federal and non-governmental agencies and organizations that provide information about substance abuse and its treatment are provided.

Links to SAMHSA's *Mental Health Services Locator* and *Buprenorphine Physician Locator* are provided. These sites are similar to the Locator. The Buprenorphine Physician Locator identifies physicians authorized to prescribe buprenorphine by zip code, city, county, or State.
